Alcohol & Drug Dependency Services

About the class

The Diversion class is composed of two parts:

Juvenile Diversion - 6 hour class for youth that is offered in two sessions.

Parent Diversion - 2 hour class for parents offered in one session.

All sessions must be attended.

The youth will be required to complete a service activity in order to complete the program.

The materials used are researched based and taken from the Prevention Research Institute, Prime For Life program. The instructors are Certified Prime for Life instructors.

Referrals

Juvenile Diversion classes serve youth 13-17 years of age. Referrals are accepted for youth who are early in their use of alcohol, tobacco or other drugs and have not yet developed chemical dependency. Referrals are accepted from school personnel, social workers, substance abuse counselors, juvenile court officers, and ministers; as well as family members.

Parent Diversion class serves parents of the youth who have been referred to Juvenile Diversion. Parents will learn how to recognize signs and symptoms of alcohol and drug use, and how to talk about alcohol and drugs with their youth.

Cost

The cost for the youth class is \$50 and for the parent class is \$25, due at the time of registration and is **non-refundable and non-transferable.**

Registration

Youth and parents can register and pay the fee at any of the ADDS offices. There is no phone registration.

The entire fee is due at the time of registration. **You may register up to noon the day of the class (if evening class) or by 5 pm the day before the class (if weekend class).** No registration fees will be accepted at the time of class.

Missing classes

You will have to re- register for the class and pay again. **No REFUNDS!**

Class Completion

Both youth sessions of a class must be attended, and service activity must be completed. Upon signing a "release of information form", a letter of completion will be sent to your referral source.

Fee Waivers

The Executive Director must approve any and all fee waivers. In order to obtain a fee waiver, you must be able to prove your inability to pay. The Executive Director may be contacted by calling 319-753-6567.

Funding has been made available to offer FREE classes to participants in Henry, Louisa, and Lee Counties in Iowa; Hancock County in Illinois; and Clark County in Missouri.
